The School District of Niagara will be sponsoring two Developmental Screening Days on **March 16, 2021 and March 18, 2021.** This event serves many purposes. First, it presents the opportunity for preschool-aged children in the district to participate in a developmental screening to assess developmental progress. It also provides parent awareness of intervention services available in the district and identifies children requiring these special services. Last, this event provides resources/materials for parents to use at home with their child. A vision and hearing screening will also be available.

Your child must be three, four, or five years old by September 1, 2021, and must be a resident in the School District of Niagara or apply for Open Enrollment to the district (http://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment) in order to participate.
