The Award

Graduates will submit a 1–2-page paper on one of the following topics:

1. Mental health issue(s) and how it relates to suicide
2. Personal experience with mental health
3. Personal experience with suicide

This twin county competition is judged by the board of directors of the Suicide Prevention Network of Marinette & Menominee Counties.

Deadline

Paper must be received by **April 5th, 2024**

Eligibility

You must be in good standing in your final year of school and scheduled to graduate in May or June, 2024. These scholarships are available to Marinette County, Wisconsin and Menominee County, Michigan students. *Students attending any secondary school (technical, 2-year or 4 year) are eligible to receive the scholarship. Up to three scholarships may be awarded for each county. Please include the field of study you plan to pursue and which school you plan to attend.*

Your Paper Should Include

1. The original manuscript and an extra copy.
2. A letter of recommendation/reference from a staff member from your school.
3. The cover page needs the title of the paper, author's name, home address and phone number, email address, high school name, high school address, and total number of pages.
4. The body of the paper cannot exceed 2 type written pages and should be double-spaced with 12-point typeface Times New Roman with one-inch margins all around.
5. Pages must be numbered.
6. Papers must be submitted by postal mail and must be received by April 5th, 2024, there will be no exceptions.

We always invite essay winners to participate in our annual Embrace Life Family Fun Walk held in the fall. Proceeds from our annual walk are what makes our scholarship awards possible.
