- 2. Must have earned a high school grade point average (GPA) between a 2.5 and 3.5 (on a scale of 4.0) based on high school records or above a 2.5 based on college records.

Instructions for completing this application:

- 1. Application is to be completed by the applicant.
- 2. Please type or print clearly.
- 3. Attach the following to your completed application:
  - a. One character reference letter from a non-family member
  - b. Transcript of completed courses
  - c. A biographical statement, including educational backgrounds, goals and other pertinent information about yourself (and your family, if you choose).

Upon proof of continued education, the scholarship will be awarded in two parts;  $\frac{1}{2}$  for the first semester, and  $\frac{1}{2}$  for the second semester. Our recipients will be honored at our May meeting.

The check will be made payable to the recipient and may be used for tuition, books, or fees.

If the recipient simply changes her mind or can't attend college for any reason, the amount received must be returned. A transcript is required before the second semester check is mailed.
