A morning milk program will be offered to students in grades 4K-5 at the cost of \$0.35 per milk.

Ala carte items will be offered to students in grades 6-12. Permission forms will be completed with your online registration for your 6th grader. The status of all other students in grades 7-12 will remain the same as last year, unless you request a change through the office. Only students with ala carte parental permission forms on file will be permitted to purchase ala carte items.

Ala carte items cannot be charged, students must pay cash or have money in their account.

Families must prepay meals. Balance notices will be sent home once accounts reach \$20.00 or less. Please check on your family’s balance frequently and deposit money as needed. There should never be a negative meal balance. Meals should be prepaid. Checks can be made out to the Niagara Public Schools or you can pay online through family access.

(There is a small processing fee applied for online payments) Please view your family access account at www.niagara.k12.wi.us. If you have any questions, please call the main office at 715-251-4541.

If you do not have a Family Access account and need your password/user name, please call the main office.

Applications for free and reduced meals will be sent home with your child and are also available in the office or on Skyward Family Access. We request that you fill this out and return the application the first week of school. It is not necessary to fill out this paperwork if you choose to complete it on-line or if your family has been direct certified.

Only one application per family/household is needed. You do not have to fill out an application if your family has been direct certified.
