In Reading and Writing

We will focus on guided reading in the classroom—I will take small groups of students and work on reading, writing, and phonics. We will continue to learn new sight words, create rhyming words, and write with inventive spelling.

In math

We will be focusing on developing an understanding of part-whole relationships. Students will recognize that a set of objects can be broken into smaller subsets without changing the total.

At Home Learning

Students will begin to write "Number Trees." They will learn that a set of objects can be split up in multiple ways. For example, 4 can be seen as 4+0, 3+1, 2+2, 1+3, or 0+4. They will represent decompositions with "number trees."
