In Reading and Writing

The election, Veteran's Day, and Thanksgiving will be some topics we are reading about. We are beginning to learn sight words: I, like, no, go, and, the, and you. Focusing on phonics goals such as rhyming, syllabication, and letter sounds.

In Math

We are counting forward and backward within 30. Numeral writing 0-20. Using 10-frames and number racks to add and subtract within five.

In Science/Social Studies

We will be learning about American traditions in the election, Veteran's Day, and Thanksgiving. In Science we will continue to focus on life cycles.

Asking questions helps you to gauge your child's thought processes and their understanding of the text. This can help with comprehension as they become independent readers.
