February Theme: Winter & Friendship

In Reading and Writing

We will continue to work on CVC words in reading and writing—identifying and blending letter sounds together. We are learning the basic structure of a sentence: capitalization, spaces in between words, and punctuation.

In math

We are learning the values of coins, counting on from 5 and 10, and practicing counting to 100 by ones. We will also continue to compare sets with greater than, less than, and equal.

In Science/Social Studies

Maps, compass rose, and map symbols are part of learning about our community. Science is animal habitats and winter survival.
