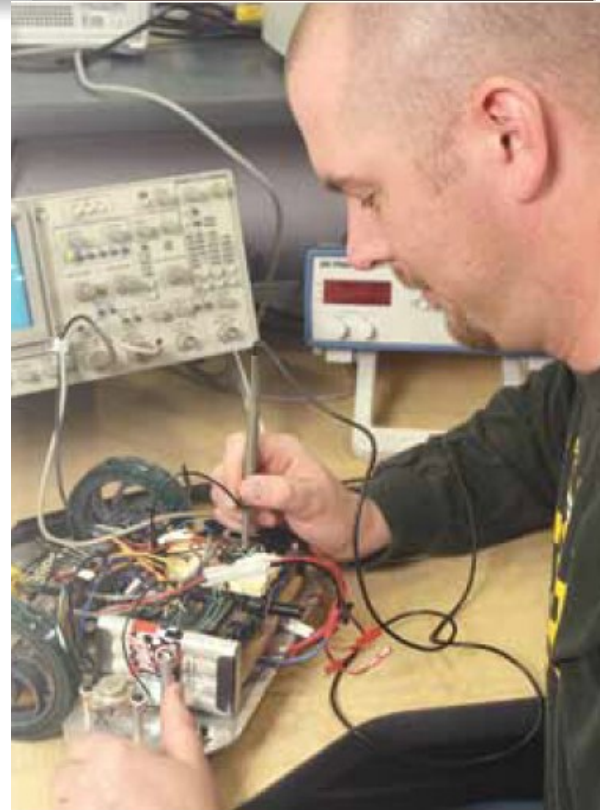

PHOTOGRAPHY & DESIGN GRAPHICS TECHNOLOGY

Annual Wages: \$31,200*

Careers: Portrait photographer, photojournalist, graphic designer, advertising assistant, website designer, commercial art worker, desktop publisher.

HEALTH CARE CUSTOMER SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE

Annual Wages: \$26,000*

Become a Health Care Customer Service Representative in a healthcare setting. Students will receive a certificate upon completion of this program.

ELECTRO-ENGINEERING

Annual Wages: \$58,000*

Careers: Automated equipment technician, electro-mechanical technician, electronics technician, field service technician and electrical test technician.

NURSING ASSISTANT

Annual Wages: \$22,000*

Perform basic nursing tasks under supervision and direction of the Registered Nurse in a nursing home or other healthcare environment. Meets the pre-requisite for the LPN program at NWTC.
