



James McCash Vocational Scholarship Letter of Intent

Amount:

\$5000 per semester renewable for up to (3) additional semesters for a total of \$20,000. The award amount may change when the fund is near depletion.

Application Requirements:

Note that due to the size of the award, the application process is more stringent than others and may require interview

Applicants must graduate high school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA to apply

Applicants must be accepted into a Community College, Vocational Trade School or other type of two-year accredited program. Preference may be given to a student pursuing a degree related to the building trades field.

Applicants must be US citizens, and be enrolled in a high school that participates in the Tech Center programs, including, IM, BTS, North Dickinson, Norway, Niagara, Florence, WIC, and FP. The student does not necessarily need to have attended classes at the Tech Center.

Finalists may be contacted for a phone interview

Accurate completion of application in its entirety. Further documentation may be required.

Recipient Requirements:

Students awarded the scholarship shall provide a copy of their transcript each semester for review prior to receiving the next semester monies. This transcript must include declared major course of study.

Recipients must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 GPA while in their program, as well as full time student status. Should they not achieve that, their scholarship may be put on probationary status or revoked at the discretion of the committee.

Agree to ongoing communication and correspondence with member(s) of the scholarship committee as requested by the committee.

If a student decides to change major or transfer to a different school, the committee reserves the right to review/revoke the scholarship.

Other items of note:

The selection committee shall consist of the three primary donors (David McCash, Colleen Lowe and Corinne Poquette or their proxy), and (1) member of the ISD faculty or administration. If a member is unable or unwilling to serve, the committee shall select another member, with preference given to members of the McCash Family.
