Welcome to the meal program offered by the School District of Niagara! Additional information is included in your child's handbook. (Also on our website)

*All students attending the School District of Niagara in grades 4K-6 are approved for the Community Eligibility Provision for the School Year 2020-2021.

This means breakfast & lunch for 4K-6 are no cost, however the Wisconsin School Day Milk Program that is served in the class room will cost \$0.35 unless your family qualifies for a free or reduced eligibility.

Ala carte items will be offered to students in grades 6-12. Permission forms should be completed with your online registration for your new 6th grader. The status of all other students in grades 7-12 will remain the same as last year, unless you request a change through the office. Only students with ala carte parental permission forms on file will be permitted to purchase ala carte items. **Please be advised that at this time there will be no cash sales or money exchange in the cafeteria area. Money must be in the family account.**

***Families must prepay meals.** There should be money in your family's account at all times. Balance notices will be sent home. Please check your family's balance often and deposit money as needed. **There should never be a negative meal balance.** Checks can be made out to Niagara Public Schools or you can pay online through family access. (There is a small processing fee applied for online payments) Please view your family access account at www.niagara.k12.wi.us. If you have any questions, please call the main office at 715-251-4541. If you do not have a Family Access account and need your password/user name, please call the main office.

Returning an application for free or reduced meals is not mandatory, but if you feel you may qualify for benefits, please fill out an application and return it to school as soon as possible for determination.
This is a family household application. Only (1) application is necessary. Applications for free and reduced meals are also available in the office or on Skyward Family Access.
Do not fill out an application if your family qualified for free meals through Direct Certification.
